Irma B. Barringer-Fairchild, 82, of Cambridge was called home by her Lord and answered his call peacefully on April 23, 2012, with her family by her side. Mrs. Fairchild was born September 12, 1923 near Canfield, Ohio daughter of the late Dewey and Blanch (McKenzie) Barringer. She graduated from Canfield High School.

Mrs. Fairchild had a heart of gold and was one of those persons who was everyone's friend. She had a passion for music and a beautiful alto voice.
