J. Carter Floyd, 95 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away July 12, 2014 at the Beckett House in New Concord, Ohio. He was born April 21, 1919 in Coshocton, Ohio to the late Ora A. & Edith (Carter) Floyd. Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his wife Louise (Mullis) Floyd of 35 years of marriage and whom passed away on September 5, 1992. He survived by his sister Ruth F. Carolina, 2 step- grandchildren Leigh Wingate of South Carolina and Al Wingate of North Carolina.
