Jack Richard Jones, age 90 of Cambridge, passed away on Saturday, December 17, 2016 at his home. He was born on July 15, 1926 in Cambridge, a son of the late Harry B. Jones and Lula M. (Thomas) Jones.

Mr. Jones served his country in the U.S. Navy during World War II and the Korean War. He was a member of the First Christian Church in Cambridge. Jack was: a life member of the V.F.W 2901; and the Elks BPOE; a member of the Guernsey Lodge #66 F&AM for over 65 years; a member of the Shrine and York Rite Bodies; and a member of the Cambridge Country Club. Jack worked in various positions for Lillienthal Southeastern Printing for over 45 years. He proudly served as secretary / treasurer of the USS St. Louis for the last 30 years, one of the ships he served on in the Navy.

Jack is preceded in death by: his parents, Harry and Lula Jones; his first wife, Betty A. Jones in 1975; his second wife, Pat A. Oliver Jones in 2004; two sisters, Eva Parrish and Marie Pulvermacher; and a brother Harry Jones. He is survived by: his wife Yvonne Frontz of the home; two sons, Terry L. (Grace) Jones of Blacklick, and Tim (Karen) Jones of New Albany; a niece and two nephews that he raised as their guardian, Barbara, Jeff and Richard Anderson; four grandchildren, Jason Jones, Marcus Jones, Sarah Blasi and Meghan Patton; ten great grandchildren; and several other nieces and nephews.
