April 22, 1935 - February 11, 2018

Jacob Kennedy, age 82 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, February 11, 2018 at his home. He was born on April 22, 1935 in Carryville, Tennessee, a son of the late Thomas Kennedy and Lassie (Phillips) Kennedy.

Mr. Kennedy served his country in the U.S. Army from 1956 to 1957. He worked at Ford Motor Company for over 35 years in several different departments. Jacob attended Mt. Hermon Presbyterian Church.
