James Lee Frost, age 67, of Tucson, AZ formerly of Cambridge, passed away after a brief battle with cancer on Friday Sept. 1, 2017 at his home. He was born on June 12, 1950 in Cambridge, a son of the late Billy J. Frost and Eileen (English) Frost.

James was a 1969 graduate of Cambridge High School, where he ran track and cross country. He then joined the U.S. Navy and served for three years from 1969 to 1972. He was stationed on the submarine Von Steuben during the Vietnam Era.

James was Methodist by faith, he was a member of the Boy Scouts, he had achieved the honors; Eagle Scout and Order of the Arrow. He was a member of the American Legion #0100 in Tucson, AZ. He worked in Arizona at Viscount Suites Hotel for many years as a prep cook.

Jimmy is survived by: two sisters, Ramona (Richard) Springer of Cambridge and Suzanne Frost of Westerville; a brother Larry (Lorraine) Frost of Cleveland; and nieces and nephews, Amy Springer, Alisa (Jay) Williams, Cory (Cassie) Springer and Thad (Janeen) Frost; and several great nieces and nephews.

Jimmy is preceded in death by his parents, and a brother John David Frost.
