John S. Greene, age 87 of Cambridge, passed away on Tuesday, June 9, 2015 at Cambridge Health Care Center. He was born on January 8, 1928 in Logan, Ohio, a son of the late Charles Richard Greene and Margaret Mable (Redd) Greene.

Mr. Greene graduated from Logan High School in 1946. He served his country in the Navy during World War II. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church; the V.F.W.
