John L. Longinie, age 74, of New Concord, OH passed away Saturday July 30, 2016 at The Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born March 25, 1942 to the late John M. Longinie and Pauline B. Mochary Longinie in Waholding, OH. John was the former owner of Longinie Insurance in Cambridge, OH. He was the current owner of BP/Delizio's at the Quaker City exit. He was a member of Christ Our Light Parish where he had served on the Parish Advisory Council for several years. After graduating from St. Benedict High School, John worked at the FBI in Washington DC. He then attended Ohio University in Athens, OH prior to serving three years in the US Army. He returned to Ohio University to earn his degree in Business Administration in 1970. He was a former member of The Cambridge Kiwanis Club, Cambridge Chamber of Commerce and Cambridge Country Club. John was a founder of the "Affair on the Square" a popular downtown social event in the 1980's. He was an avid golfer and fan of the Cleveland Indians, Ohio State Buckeyes and John Glenn Muskies. He was known affectionately as "Johnny Bingo" within his Cardinal Place friends and family.

John is survived by his wife Norma J. DeStephen Longinie whom he married July 12, 1969 and one daughter Lori (Richard) Bubenchik of Norwich, OH. His pride and joy was his granddaughter Lexi Bubenchik. He enjoyed watching her high school career in golf, dance, cheer and pageants. He looked forward to her high school senior year and college golf career. John is survived by his aunt Virginia Chebra of Cleveland, OH and several cousins. He also enjoyed

spending time with his special companion, the family dog Bella Mia.
