John William "Bill" McCulloch, age 65 of Cambridge passed away on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 at Select Specialty Hospital in Newark. He was born on October 26, 1951 in Cambridge, a son of the late Robert F. McCulloch and Lola F. (Harding) McCulloch.
