



John Thomas "Tom" McMullen

July 23, 1937 - July 7, 2017

John Thomas "Tom" McMullen age 79, passed away on July 7, 2017 at Cambridge Health and Rehab Center after recently being diagnosed with an aggressive brain tumor. He was born on July 23, 1937, at his home in Cambridge, Ohio to the late Herbert and Lucille (Guthrie) McMullen. He was a graduate of Cambridge High School, served peace time in the Army and was married to the late Joyce (Gibson) McMullen.

Tom was always telling jokes and making people laugh and smile. His laughter could be heard from the opposite end of Riesbecks where he retired from being a manager. In addition to being in the grocery business, his true passion was farming. From raising chickens, pigs, cattle, sheep and donkeys (along with a stray cat or two and numerous pet dogs), bailing hay in the hottest days of summer to mowing, Tom was usually outside working. Farming was always his life passion.

He also enjoyed spending time with his coffee, newspaper and diner friends. He was always committed to being involved in the community: Kiwanis, Cambridge Chamber of Commerce, a lifelong member of the Ohio Farm Bureau Association and recently serving on The Salvation Army Advisory Board.

He is preceded by his brother, Dale McMullen of Caldwell, and survived by his daughter, Kerri McMullen of Cambridge, his sister Connie (McMullen) Ansberry of Cambridge, and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins of which will greatly miss his laughter.

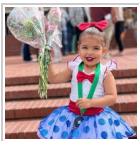
