John W. Winget, age 67 of Cambridge passed away Wednesday, March 23, 2011 at his residence after a brief bout with pancreatic cancer. He was born in Londonderry on March 8, 1944, a son of the late Harry "Jack" Taylor Winget and Kathleen (Hamilton) Winget.
