Joseph Dwight Eagleson, age 50 of Byesville, passed away Saturday, August 20, 2011 at Grant Medical Center in Columbus following a machinery accident. He was born in Cambridge on January 12, 1961, a son of Clifford H. Eagleson and Mary Lou (Pullen) Eagleson of Byesville.

Mr. Eagleson was a 1979 graduate of Meadowbrook High School and Guernsey Noble Vocational School. He grew up working in the family business where he became the dedicated owner of Eagleson's Inc. He was a member of the Byesville Rotary and enjoyed four wheeling and boating. He leaves: his parents, Clifford and Mary Lou; his wife, Cynthia J.
