Joseph Mizikar, age 99, of Cambridge, OH passed away Friday November 11, 2016 at The Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born February 22, 1917, in Trail Run later known as Robins, Ohio. Son of the late Joseph Mizikar Sr. and the late Mary (Petras) Mizikar.

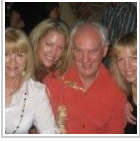
