Joseph Frank Stavely, age 92 of Cambridge, passed away on Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at his home. He was born on March 29, 1929 in Jacksonville, Florida, a son of the late Eddie Stavely and Nellie Irene (Smith) Stavely. Mr. Stavely was a 1947 graduate of Cambridge High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Air Force in 1948 and spent 5 years in Japan as a cost accountant. He also played basketball for the Air Force while in Japan. Joe was Baptist by faith and had worked at NCR, RCA and E.G. Smith. He was a member of the Cambridge V.F.W. Post 2901. He enjoyed fast pitch softball and pitched until he was over 70 years old. He loved golfing and bowling and was an avid fan of the Ohio State Buckeyes. A favorite pastime of Joe's was sitting on his tractor mowing the grass.
