Kathy J. Milligan, age 64 of Cambridge passed away on Sunday, May 1, 2022 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville. She was born in Dennison, Ohio on August 19, 1957, a daughter of Larry and Carol (McCullough) Caldwell of Cambridge. Kathy was a certified dental technician servicing the Cambridge area.
