



## Kenneth Eugene Kenworthy

May 25, 1935 - April 10, 2018

Kenneth Eugene Kenworthy, age 82 of Cambridge, passed away on Tuesday, April 10, 2018 at SEORMC. He was born on May 25, 1935 in Cambridge, a son of the late Charles Kenworthy and Gertrude (Geyer) Kenworthy.

Mr. Kenworthy was a 1953 graduate of Cambridge High School. He served his country in the U.S. Army during the Korean Era from 1958-1960. Kenny was a printer at the Daily Jeffersonian for over 50 years, he retired in 2001. He was a member of the Bloomfield Presbyterian Church and had been a deacon for 16 years. He enjoyed bowling and loved playing softball. He was inducted into the amateur softball hall of fame in 1984 and was the district softball commissioner in this area. Ken started "Fun Night" through the church during the summer months, where the community came out to play volleyball and softball.

Ken is survived by: his wife Mary Jane (Wells) Kenworthy, they were married on August 6, 1983; a daughter Jennifer Kenworthy of Seattle, WA and a stepson Randall (Kelly) Moore of Powell; two grandchildren, Ella and Colin; a brother Herbert Kenworthy of Cambridge; a sister Arnette Stroud of Cambridge; several nieces and nephews; his caregivers Jen and Mary and the staff in the Intensive Care Unit at SEORMC.

Kenny is preceded in death by his parents and a brother Bernard Kenworthy. Visitation will be on Friday, April 13, 2018 at Bundy-Law Funeral Home from 5 to 8 pm. His service will be on Saturday, April 14, 2018 at 2:30 pm also at Bundy-Law Funeral Home with Pastor Tim Pollock officiating. Burial will follow
