Kiristi Diane (Grimsley) Miller, age 66 of Byesville, OH, slipped peacefully into the arms of our Heavenly father at sunrise on Saturday, March 21, 2015 surrounded by her family after a courageous battle with cancer. Kiristi, devoted wife, loving mother and adored grammy was born on June 14, 1948 in Freeport, OH, the youngest of four children, to the late Vernon "Darby" and Mary Edith (Wilson) Grimsley. She graduated from Madison High School in 1966 and very briefly attended Kent State University before marrying her high school sweetheart, Larry Miller on January 7, 1967. Throughout the years, Kiristi was employed at various businesses (NCR, March Electric, The Wagon Wheel, Morton Tax Service, Millers Tax Service and Kaplet's Market), but her number one priority was always her family. She was an active member of the Winterset and Trinity United Methodist Churches, the Adair Bible Class and Birmingham Homemakers Club in years past. She was also a proud member & inspiration for the "Kiristi Tribe" who have raised over \$100,000 for the American

Cancer Society's fight against cancer through the Relay for Life and Making Strides Against Breast Cancer. Kiristi enjoyed reading, doing crossword puzzles, watching her favorite shows, catching up with dear friends on the telephone and chatting with neighbors on the front porch, but most of all loved spending time with family and spoiling her grandchildren which were her absolute pride and joy!!

Kiristi is preceded in death by her parents; a sister, Sandra Waggoner (and brother-in-law, Kenneth "Butch"); a brother, William Grimsley; and several aunts, uncles, nephews, nieces and cousins. She is survived by loving husband, Larry; two daughters: Wendy (Phillip) Marino of Powell, OH and Candy (John) Pauk of Marysville, OH; three grandchildren: Chandler Pauk, Alyssa Marino and Cady Pauk; a brother, John Grimsley (Arlene) of Kimbolton, OH; and several nieces, nephews, cousins and many dear friends.

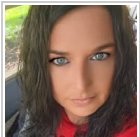
