The family of Kris Andrew Froehlich, of Cambridge, OH, is saddened to announce his passing on Oct. 30th, 2025.

Born March 25, 1975 in Zanesville, OH, Kris was a graduate of Cambridge High School and attended Waynesburg College. He worked as a tower climber on cell phone towers -which he claimed made him feel closer to God. A Celebration of Life to honor Kris will be held at a later date.

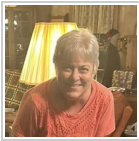
