



Kurt B. Tostenson

August 2, 1957 - January 2, 2017

Kurt B. Tostenson, age 59 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday, January 2, 2017 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville. He was born in Columbus on August 2, 1957, a son of the late Neal S. Tostenson and Beverly A. (Rawlins) Tostenson.

Mr. Tostenson was a 1975 graduate of Cambridge High School. He then went to Ohio University for his Bachelors Degree. Kurt worked with his family in the Open Door Book Store until its closing in early 2000. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church and a long standing member of the Cambridge Singers and the City Band. He was a board member for CPAC, an original cast member for the Living Word and a member of the Guernsey County Historical Society. Kurt was also a past member of the Guernsey County Genealogy Society. He enjoyed history and genealogy and was an avid photographer.

Kurt is survived by: two sisters, Ann (Randy) Lawrence of Cambridge and Amy (Jeff) Booth of Blacklick; a brother Neal H. (Debbie Beros) Tostenson of Cambridge; two nephews, Ben (Denise) Lawrence of Cambridge and Jeffery Booth of Columbus and a great nephew Anthony Lawrence.

Visitation will be on Thursday, January 5, 2017 at Bundy-Law Funeral Home from 6 to 8 pm. Kurt's service will be held on Friday, January 6, 2017 at 11 am also at Bundy-Law. Pastor Max Beery will officiate the service with burial to follow in Northwood Cemetery.
