January 9, 1915 - October 28, 2003

Lawrence Lewis Gable, age 88, of Cambridge died Tuesday Morning October 28, 2003 at Cambridge Health Care Center. He was born January 9, 1915 in Bellville, Ohio the son of the late Lewis and Edith Oswalt Gable. He attended school in Bellville and Butler, Ohio.

He was married on June 15, 1936 to Priscilla Pat Ann Mason.

He was in sales all his working years. He worked for Mansfield Coca Cola, Northrup Seed Co., Jackson Potato Chips, and Nickles Baking Co. from which he retired after 30 years. He began working for Nickles in 1942 at the Mansfield branch, transferring to Coshocton, and then to the Cambridge branch. He had the same Cambridge route for 21 years, serving restruants, grocery stores, and schools. After retirement in 1972, he and his wife Pat relocated to Florida where for 5 years they managed mobil home parks in Bradenton, Sarasota, Palma Sola, Gulf Breeze on Siesta Key, and Maxwell Park at Dunedin. After returning to the Cambridge area, Lawrence worked at Cambridge Park and Shop until his health would no longer permit.

He was a member of Kimbolton United Methodist Church and Teamsters Local #637.

Lawrence loved animals and had many hobbies. He enjoyed Go Cart Racing, hunting, camping, and traveling both by car and tour bus. Several memorable vacations were spent with his family at Myrtle Beach. He loved wood working and many have been the privileged recipients of his loving hand work. He liked playing cards and watching T. V. He truly enjoyed the many get togethers
