Leslie M. Smith age 96 of Cambridge, died Monday, June 22, 2009 at his home. He was born in Guernsey County, a son of the late George F. and Margaret O'Conner Smith.

Mr. Smith was employed at Continental Can until it closed in 1953, then to the Henry Keiser Plant at Shadyside, Ohio until an opening at Chrysler Corporation in Twinsburg, Oh. for a tool maker in 1959. Les drove back and forth every few days maintaining his home and family in Cambridge.

He retired from Chrysler May 31, 1978. He was the oldest living member of the First United Methodist Church in Cambridge.
