Lillie Remer Moorhead age 100 of Cambridge, passed away Tuesday, October 19, 2010 at her home from a battle with Alzheimer's disease. She was born on September 13, 1910 in Cambridge, a son of the late Harry Lieb Remer and Mary (Foraker) Remer.

Lillie was a retired school teacher, working several years in Cambridge Schools and other Guernsey County Schools.
