



Lionel Bud D. Lagneaux

November 10, 1921 - July 27, 2002

Lionel D. "Bud" Lagneaux, age 80, of Cambridge, died Saturday, July 27, 2002, at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. Son of the late Lionel Lagneaux and Amelia Stevadore Lagneaux.

Mr. Lagneaux's occupations included; working for Cambridge Glass Co., he was Capt. of Security for RCA and NCR, and Owner and Operator of Bud's Pub. He was Methodist by Faith. He served in the Pacific Theater as a Marine during W.W.II. A Life Member of the V.F.W. Post 2901, Bud was a master gardner and a master cook. He was proud of the fact that he played softball with John F. Kennedy in the South Pacific. He was also an avid reader of historical literature and was most knowledgable about the Civil War.

Bud is survived by his wife Marjorie Thatcher Lagneaux, whom he married on March 30, 1948, she lives in their home.
