



## Louanna M. Rogers

September 19, 1939 - July 17, 2021

Louanna M. Rogers, age 81, of Cambridge, OH passed away 9:19 a.m. Saturday July 17, 2021 at her home after a lengthy battle with cancer. She was surrounded by her family. Louanna was born September 19, 1939 to the late Rev. Delmar Johnson and Dora (Downar) Johnson in Gibson Station, OH. Louanna was raised in a strong christian home. Through her faith in the Lord Jesus Christ she touched her family and the lives of many friends. Her grandchildren and great grandchildren were the love of her life. She was a member of The First Baptist Church in Cambridge since 1959 where she taught Sunday School, served on The Board of Christian Education, sang in the choir. She along with Sandy West co chaired the prayer chain at the church. Louanna graduated from Senecaville High School and then attended Cambridge Lab Technician College. Louanna was a lab technician at Guernsey Memorial Hospital in the 1960's. She worked with her husband Dale E. Rogers from 1974 until his retirement in 2000 at the family business, Rogers Radiator. She bowled in the womens league at King Pin Lanes in the 1970's.

Along with her parents Louanna is preceded in death by: a brother, Bert Johnson, a sister-in-law, Shirley Johnson (Leroy) Merce, a nephew, step parents, Robert "Bob" Tignor and Lillian Johnson Tignor.
