Margaret D. Crapoff, age 80 of Lore, City, passed away on Sunday, April 21, 2024 at Countryview Assisted Living Center. She was born in Monroe, Michigan on June 21, 1943, a daughter of the late John G. Ondrejko and Irma (Gaydos) Ondrejko.

Mrs. Crapoff was a 1961 graduate of St. Benedict's High School. She attended Good Samaritan Nursing School in Zanesville and then Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity in Manitowoc, WI.
