June 30, 1922 - July 19, 2009

Margaret M. Cunningham, age 87 of Cambridge, died Sunday, July 19, 2009 at the Victorian Oaks Assisted Living Center. She was born on June 30, 1922 in Cambridge, a daughter of the late David Waldo Johnson and Pauline LeVrangi Johnson.

Mrs. Cunningham was a member of the Center United Methodist Church where she was well known for her "Children's Church" lessons. She joined the Order of Eastern Star #211 in 1975 where she served as a Worthy Matron in 1989 and 1993. During W.W.II she was trained by the Standard Oil Co. to serve on the home front as a Sohioette. Later she served Cambridge City Schools where she was the secretary to the superintendent. She was named Secretary of the year by the Cambridge Chapter of NSA in this position in 1956. She left in 1958 to work in the home and raise her children. She later returned to work and retired from Cambridge MH & DD Center.

Margaret was preceded in death by: her husband, Harold M. Cunningham on July 2, 1991, they were married on December 12, 1953; a sister, Dolly Jean Johnson; and a brother, William Robert Johnson.

She leaves: two sons, John David Cunningham and William Howard Cunningham both of Cambridge; and a sister, Janet Neilly of Cambridge.
