Mari-an Teresa Brill, age 96 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away on July 8, 2017 after a short illness at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. She was born on August 8, 1920 in Cambridge, Ohio to the late Pete and Elizabeth (Swacus) Zuke. Also preceding her in death was her husband Carl F. Brill on January 30, 1986, three sisters Marjorie Dziuban, Helen Stage, and Julia Lakey, a brother Edward Zuke and half-brother Sergei Zuke, and two brother-in-laws, Frank Dziuban and Hank Lakey. She was a member of Christ Our Light Parish Church, Catholic Daughter's Club, Ladies Auxiliary of VFW, member of the Chamber of Commerce. She moved to Michigan from 1951 to 1971 and worked at Hillside Inn Restaurant in Plymouth, Michigan, in 1972 she started working at the Cambridge State Hospital as a nurse's aide. She help start up Hillview Acres Campgrounds and Hillview Storage. After retirement she was a snowbird in Lakeland, Florida, after 5 years she got her own place and spent more time in Florida than in Ohio. While in Lakeland she help Resurrection Catholic Church on fund-raisers when she worked in the booth at the stadium where the Cleveland Indians had spring training and also worked the booth at Lakeland International Fly In. She worked at Talbot House Ministries, a organization that gives hope for the hungry, homeless, and the poor. The last few years she was a resident of the Countryview Assisted Living in Lore City. Mari-an is survived by her son Buddy (Donna) Brill of Cambridge and several nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews, and great-great nieces and nephews. Calling hours will be from
