Marjorie Myrtle Jackson DeVault was born October 15, 1913, in Holloway, Ohio, to Charles and Myrtle Jackson. She graduated from Holloway High School and from Ruth Brant School of Nursing in Martins Ferry, Ohio. She served as Director of Nursing at the former Cambridge State Hospital. She was a charter member of Wing 13 at Southeastern Hospital and was a member of the Guernsey County Cancer Society and American Red Cross. Mrs. DeVault was also a member of the Red Cross Blood Mobile for 25 years. As a member of the First Methodist Church, she attended the Co-Ed Sunday school class. She was also a very avid bridge player.

Mrs. DeVault and James William DeVault were married August 31, 1935. She was preceded in death by her husband on April 29, 1974, and by her daughter, Gary DeVault Gold, on May 21, 2016. She leaves behind one daughter and son-in-law, Pamela and Andrew Hamblin, of Montgomery, IL, and son-in-law, Larry Gold, of Sheridan, WY. She also leaves behind one sister, one brother, four granddaughters, two grandsons and eleven great grandchildren.
