Mark R. Warner, 49 of Grove City, OH. formerly of Cambridge, OH. passed away Wednesday, October 15, 2008 at the residence of his parents in Cambridge. He was born on October 30, 1958 in Cambridge to Robert C. "Sam" and Janice J. Griffith Warner.

Mark was Episcopal by faith and was a Nursing Home Administrator. He worked at Sharonview, Cambridge Health Care, Bon-Ing Care Center and at VOCA. Mark graduated from Cambridge High School in 1977. He received a BA degree in education from Ohio University; and a Masters degree in Policy and Public Administration from Ohio State University.

He was an amazing loving father of: 3 sons, twin boys, Branden and Blake age 18 and Ben age 10. The mother of his children is Jill Cox Warner, an R.N. at the Ohio State University Medical Center.
