



Mary Ann Mitchell

July 23, 1926 - July 9, 2013

Mary Ann (Mills) Mitchell, 86, succumbed to Alzheimer's disease and passed away at home surrounded by her loving family and care givers on July 9, 2013.

She was born July 23, 1926 in Columbus, Ohio, the oldest child of the late Bruce Mills and the late Kathleen Mills Gormley. Mary Ann began a career as a private duty nurse in 1948 after graduating from the Mount Carmel School of Nursing in Columbus as a member of the final graduating class sponsored by the Army Corps of Nurses. She later worked at both Swan and Guernsey Memorial Hospitals in Cambridge. She began a career in industrial nursing at RCA in 1965 and finished the final 22+ years of her career in 1988 as the Manager of Medical Services and Workers Compensation for NCR Corporation in Cambridge. She was a proud participant in the Harvard Nurses Study from its inception. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church. Mary Ann married John Edward "Ed" Mitchell on November 15, 1949 in Hollywood, CA, and appeared on the radio show "Bride and Groom" after entering an essay contest to win the trip, wedding, honeymoon and an array of gifts.
