Matthew Victor Mazur, age 67 of Columbus, formerly of Cambridge, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 20, 2019.

Matthew was born in Akron, Ohio on July 23, 1952, son of the late John Mazur and Mary (Bercik) Mazur. 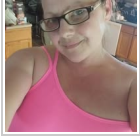
