



## Matthew Mark Smith

October 16, 1983 - March 11, 2012

Matthew Mark Smith age 28 of Cambridge, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, March 11, 2012 at the Music Venue in Youngstown, Ohio. He was born on October 16, 1983 in Akron, son of Pastor Mark B. Smith and Deborah S. Lepp Smith of Cambridge.

Matt was a 2002 graduate of Cambridge High School and attended Liberty University of Virginia. He was a member of First Baptist Church and Young Life. He previously worked with the Coppins family at Blind Horse Knives and was employed with Kevin Scott at Nevermore Tattoos. The passion of his life was music which led to his career as a professional musician.

Matt leaves behind: his parents, Mark and Debi; a sister Malisa Smith of Cambridge; a paternal grandmother Charlene Smith of North Canton, formerly of Byesville; many aunts, uncles and cousins; church family & band family members.

He is preceded in death by paternal grandfather, Bernard C. Smith and maternal grandparents Earl & Gladys Lepp.

Matthew lived his life by this following quote by Kathe Kullwitz " I do not want to die... until I have faithfully made the most of my talent and cultivated the seed that was placed in me until the last small twig has grown."

Visitation will be on Wednesday, March 14, 2012 at Bundy-Law Funeral Home from 2 to 4 pm and 6 to 9 pm. The funeral service will be held at First Baptist Church on Thursday, March 15, 2012 at 11 am with his father Pastor Mark Smith and Rev. Tim Smith officiating. Burial will follow in Northwood Cemetery.
