Oscar E. Brown, age 76 of Cambridge, passed away on Friday, January 12, 2018 at Cambridge Care and Rehabilitation. He was born in New Albany, Indiana on August 7, 1941, a son of the late Oscar Lee Brown and Lorena (Blake) Brown.

Mr. Brown was graduated from New Albany High School, Asbury University in Moorehead, Kentucky and United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio.

Oscar pastored for many years before coming to Cambridge. He worked for J.L Coats Trucking and Drilling for 8 years. He also pastored Central Christian Church in Quaker City for 20 years. In 1989 he started Big "O" Cleaning Inc. Oscar attended the First Church of the Nazarene in Cambridge. He was also an active member of the Cambridge Lions Club.

Oscar leaves: his wife of 37 years, Julia M. (Stapp) Brown; three children, Dr. Sherry Lynn Dean Rovelo (Carlos) of DeSoto, TX., John Paul Brown of Lakeview, OH. and William L. Brown of Cambridge.
