Patricia Howell Vaughan, age 69, of Byesville, OH passed away Saturday March 9, 2024 at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. Patricia was born August 16, 1954 to the late Robert Howell and Ellen Fulton Howell in Wheeling, WV. Patricia grew up in Flushing, Ohio on a dairy farm which instilled a great work ethic. She graduated from Wheeling Nursing School and earned her RN degree. She worked at several nursing facilities and ran the Skilled Nursing Facility for Guernsey Memorial Hospital. She later went on to be the Working Administrator for Hospice of Guernsey where she would go into people's homes for end of life care. She then went to work at The Morrison House in Zanesville and at the same time she worked with Oncology Services through Genesis Hospital after receiving training from The James Cancer Center. She retired from The Area Agency On Aging District 9. Pat helped thousands of people cross over to meet the Lord. Now she is rejoicing with all of those she helped in the presents of the Lord.
