Paul R. Boggs, 92, formerly of Cambridge, passed away Thursday, May 7, 2015, at The Beckett House in New Concord following a prolonged struggle with Alzheimer's disease. He was born May 20, 1922, in Waterloo, OH, son of the late Roger and Ollie Miller Boggs.

Mr. Boggs was a veteran of WWII, having served with the U.S. Army Military Police in the Pacific Theater. After the war, his jobs included long distance truck driver, steel mill worker, painter, and most recently, bartender at the old Berwick Hotel.
