



Phyllis Burchfield Fulton

June 15, 1911 - June 21, 2012

Phyllis Burchfield Fulton, age 101 of Cambridge passed away on Thursday, June 21, 2012 at the Cardinal House. She was born on June 15, 1911 in Titusville, PA, daughter of the late Dr. Samuel Newton Burchfield and the late Isabelle Campbell Burchfield.

Mrs. Fulton was one of the original Women Air Force Special Pilots (W.A.S.P.) that flew soldiers where they needed to go during W.W. II. She propagated her own iris flowers, was a published poet and had prize winning German Shepherds.

She is preceded in death by her parents, her husband, George P. Fulton on September 8, 1991, two sisters, Melloe Phillips & Mary Phillips Jones and one brother, William R. Burchfield.

She leaves a sister, Bettina Myers (Joseph Benson - dec.) of Ashtabula, Ohio and Kerrville, TX; six nieces and nephews, numerous great nieces and nephews and great great nieces and nephews, her dog Pange and several cats.

In keeping with her wishes cremation has taken place. A celebration of life will be held on Wednesday, July 11, 2012 at 2 pm at Old Washington Presbyterian Church.
