Pryse Dunigan, age 89 of Cambridge, died Wednesday, November 11, 2009 at Red Carpet Health Care Center. He was born on August 18, 1920 in Beattyville, Kentucky, a son of the late John Dunigan and Nellie Lynch Dunigan.

Mr. Dunigan worked in Bridge Construction for Bomont Bridge Company. He also had his own Floor and Tile Business.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Cambridge. He served his country in the U.S. Army and received a Purple Heart, American Campaign Medal; the W.W.II Victory Medal; and many others. He was a 50 year member of the Masonic Lodge, was a 32 Degree Mason Scottish Rite Valley of Cambridge, a member of the Co-Wed Sunday Class of the Church and a member of the V.F.W. #2901.

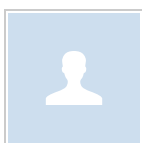
