Ralph B. Tidrick, 89, of Antrim died Saturday May 4, 2002 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center, Cambridge, Ohio. He was born March 31, 1913 near Birmingham. He was the son of the late Wesley and Anna Beal Tidrick.
