Rev. Wm Roy Grindstaff, age 90 of New Concord, OH went to be with the Lord Thursday Feb., 21, 2013 at The Altercare of Canal Winchester. He was born May 13, 1922 to the late William Walter Grindstaff and Lillian M. Grindstaff. Roy was a Navy Aviator in World War II. He served 20 years in the US Navy. Graduated with honors from Mt. Vernon Bible College and was ordained as a minister in the Foursquare Gospel Church. He served as a pastor for many years. He furthered his education to become a licensed practical nurse and worked for 15 years at Guernsey Memorial Hospital (SEORMC). He was a member of Grange and the Indian Camp Community Church. Roy had a passion for the Gospel of Jesus Christ and for serving others.
