Richard F. Long, age 93, of Cambridge died Monday afternoon at the Cambridge Health and Rehabilitation Center. He was born June 4, 1909 in Cambridge the son of the late Frank R. and Mary Olive Stiers Long. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and was Owner and operator of Long's Motel in Cambridge. Mr. Long had worked at the Courthouse in the Auditors Office, was a Nationwide Insurance Agent and worked at Central National Bank. He was a 59 year member of Guernsey Lodge #632 F & AM of Cambridge where he was a Past Secretary and Past Master of the Lodge in 1968. Richard became a Master Mason May 1, 1944. He was a Past District Education Officer of the 23rd Masonic District, a Past District Deputy Grand Master for the 23rd Masonic District, a member of the Past Masters Association of the 23rd Masonic District where he served as President from 1971-1972. A 32nd Degree member of the Valley of Cambridge, Ancient And Accepted Scottish Rite where he directed the 5th Degree. Order of Ameranth & Eastern Star Chapter 211, member of the Masonic Veterans Association, Cambridge Rotary Club, Paul Harris Fellow and a member of the White Shrine.

He was preceded in death by 1 Brother Clay Long.

He is survived by his wife Nancy Porter Long at home, 3 Sons Paul and Irene Long of Westerville, Ohio, Robert "Bob" Long of Cambridge and David S and Gabrielle Long of Ft. Lauderdale, Fl. 1 Sister Ruth Irene Weisenstine of Delaware, Ohio, 8 Grandchildren, 3 Great Grandchildren.
