Richard Lee Hagans, age 64 of Cambridge, passed away on Thursday, October 1, 2020 at his home. He was born on March 6, 1956 in Walhounding, Ohio, a son of the late Donis Royal Hagans and Alice Lucille (Kohl) Hagans. Mr. Hagans served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1973 -1974 and was in the reserves for an additional 4 years. He was a long time member of Faith United Methodist Church. He had worked at Guernsey County Courthouse for around 10 years and Picoma Industries for 12 years.

Richard was instrumental in starting the Cambridge Mens softball league in the 1980's. He coached the men's league and also coached in his daughters softball leagues. He loved to hunt and fish and enjoyed his nightly fire around his fire ring.

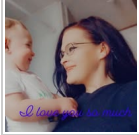
