Richard (Dick) Kissinger, age 82, beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle and friend, of Cambridge passed away on Sunday November 14th, 2010. Dick was born on May 12, 1928 in Center Township of Guernsey County, the son of the late Benjamin B. Kissinger and Gertrude Steele Kissinger.
