



## Richard L. "Mike" Eltringham

February 24, 1928 - January 17, 2018

Richard L. "Mike" Eltringham, age 89 of Cambridge passed away on Wednesday, January 17, 2018 at Riverside Methodist Hospital in Columbus. He was born on February 24, 1928 in Lore City, Ohio, a son of the late John W. Eltringham and Stella (McCreary) Eltringham.

Mr. Eltringham served his country in the U.S.Navy during the Korean War. He was a gunner's mate aboard the USS Manchester.
