



## Robert "Bob" F. Lahmers

February 1, 1928 - June 9, 2004

Robert F. "Bob" Lahmers, age 76, of Byesville, died Wednesday, June 9, 2004 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center.

Born in Dover, Ohio February 1, 1928 to Floyd and Elizabeth Lahmers.

Graduated from Dover High School and The Ohio State University majoring in Agriculture. While in college he worked at the Edward Schaar Coal Company, his uncle's coal mine.

Served in the U.S. Army stationed at Ft. Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas, where he met his wife of 51 years, Catherine M. "Kay" Kosub. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary last year camping at Hocking Hills State Park surrounded by their 5 children, their grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He was named Chief Industrial Engineer in 1958, Chief Manufacturing Engineer in 1964, Manufacturing Manager in 1966 and Plant Manager in 1969. He retired with 37 years of service in 1995.

He was active in the community throughout his career serving on the boards of Junior Achievement, United Way, the YMCA, Chamber of Commerce, and the Kiwanis.

After retirement he and Kay Mmoved to a beef farm in Byesville, where he became active in the Pennyroyal Ruritan Club. He was a member of the Bethlehem United Methodist Church in Byesville.
