Robert B. Greeger, age 88, of Cambridge died Saturday November 27, 2004 at Cambridge Health and Rehabilitation Center.

He was born December 27, 1915 in Silver Spring, Pa. the son of the late Harry and Charlotte Kutz Greeger.
