October 15, 1935 - August 1, 2020

Robert D. "Bob" Barlock age 84 of Cambridge, passed away on Saturday, August 1, 2020 at Altercare of Cambridge. He was born October 15, 1935 in Byesville, a son of the late Andrew Barlock and Jessie (Hill) Barlock Miller. Bob graduated from Byesville High School in 1955 and was drafted into the U.S. Army and served from 1958 to 1962. He was a member of St. Benedict's Catholic Church and a life member of the V.F.W. He worked as an art director for Universal Studios and for Disney World. In 1986 Bob designed the Guernsey County Flag, his design was chosen out of over 700 other designs.
