Robert Raymond Kafury, age 72 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday December 20, 2021 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born on May 30, 1949, a son of the late William Kafury and Peggy (Balsley) Kafury.

Mr. Kafury was a Lieutenant on the Cambridge Police Department where he had worked for 23 years. He then started a second career as a paraprofessional at Cambridge City Schools in the Jr High and High School for over 22 years. Bob was a member of the Jerry Dragosin FOP Lodge #10. He was a huge Ohio State fan and loved and cherished his family more than anything.

“ First of all, I want to express my deepest condolences to the Kafury family and friends. A lifelong memory I've shared with Bob goes back to our freshman year in high school. Bob and I were at practice on the football field. We were having tackling drills, where you have two lines of players facing each other. One player gets to run the ball from one line and one player from the other line makes the tackle. When my turn came, I was facing Bob. He was I guess about 5'10" and weighed 220 lbs. I was 5' and weighed 98 lbs. Bob ran the ball at me and I knew I'd be creamed if I didn't take some sort of action. I dove for his lower legs connecting solidly with my helmet. I remember rolling out of the way as he crashed to the ground. He would have smashed my frail body for sure. He lay there in pain as I feared for my life for what I'd done to him. Carl Dupler our coach called for a stretcher and they carried Bob to the dressing room. Now I figure I'm really in for it. I went straight home from practice without a shower thinking Bob would retaliate on me. The next day at school I tried to avoid him, then suddenly I saw him limping my way. My heart pounded as I feared what was next. Bob walked up to me, put his hand on my shoulder and said, Bill, I want you to know..... that's the hardest hit I have ever had playing football. He smiled real big like he was proud of me and not upset at all. That was Bob as I knew him. Several times over the years when we would see each other, he'd shake his head and say, I still remember that hit. Rest In Peace my friend.
