Robert F. McCarty, age 81 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away peacefully April 2, 2017 at his residence. He was born on February 15, 1936 in Chillicothe, Ohio. Bob was a 1954 graduate of Huntington High School in Chillicothe. He graduated in 1959 from Ohio University with a Bachelor of Science Electrical Engineer degree. Robert served three years in the United States Air Force as a communications officer and four years in the Air Force Reserves earning the rank of Captain. He worked at RCA, and retired from NCR as an electrical engineer. He had served the Cambridge Plant in the project data transmission engineering department, and was involved in design and development of new computer related systems and products. He retired a second time from Custom Technical Services. He was a member of the Institute of Electrical Engineers, and the Cambridge Engineering Society. He was a member of Christ Our Light Parish/ St. Benedicts Catholic Church; in addition Bob served on the Parish Senate and as treasurer and activity chairman of Cambridge Council 1641 of the Knights of Columbus, and was Grand Knight and Trustee. He enjoyed sports both as a participant and as a spectator. He was a avid OSU Buckeyes and Cincinnati Reds fan and enjoyed golfing with friends. Bob is preceded in death by: his parents Homer and Agnes (Fink) McCarty, an infant son Mark Robert McCarty, 2 brothers William and Patrick McCarty, and 4 sisters Kathleen McNaughton, Rose Shoemaker, Betty Brundige and Rita Sanders. Robert is survived by his wife Mary Lou (Oliver) McCarty of Cambridge and whom he married on June 12, 1965, a son Patrick McCarty of
