Roger A. Adair, age 76 of Cambridge, passed away on Monday, June 8, 2026 at Ohio Health Southeastern Medical Center. He was born on September 13, 1949 in Columbus, a son of the late Arthur R. Adair and Helen Marie (Monosky) Adair.

Mr. Adair had attended St. Benedict's Elementary School and Graduated from Cambridge High School in 1968. He served his country in the U.S. Marine Corp during the Vietnam War. Roger worked at GTE for over 35 years. He had Adair Telephone Company and installed many area telephone systems. He was a Lifetime Member of the Cambridge V.F.W. 2901 and Catholic by faith. He was a railroad enthusiast. He enjoyed collecting model trains and prototype railroad memorabilia.
