In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his in-laws, Lawrence G. and Edna L. Moffatt Winnett, and three brothers, Robert, Hugh, and Joseph. He is survived by two sisters, Betty Cooper, and Mary Alice Lerner, and one brother, Jack Mc Manus. He is also survived by his brother and sister-in-law, Wilmer L. PeeWee and Bonnie J. Roger was Catholic, and as a young man, attended St. Benedict School and Church.

Roger spent over 50 years as a mechanic, beginning at Red Sweet's Garage when he was still a teenager. He went on to work for 32 years at Cambridge Motor and Storage, and finished his career at C & L Service Center, and Classic Ford. Although Roger was a Ford man through and through, he was known as the man to go to if a person had any car problem. If he couldn't fix it, it couldn't be fixed.

Roger had many interests, beginning with auto racing. He was a mechanic for several local dirt track teams in the 50's and 60's. He helped to create the local go-cart club in the 60's. He attended the Indy 500 for 60 years, went to over 100 Nascar races, and spent the last few years watching his grandson, Ryan, participate in SCCA. He was a bowler for over 40 years, and especially enjoyed bowling with his son, Bob, in the Elks League. Through the years, he attended his children's, grandchildren's, and great-grandchildren's sporting events. Although he had always liked football, basketball and baseball, through his grandchildren's participation, he learned to also enjoy golf and soccer. With his family and friends, he enjoyed camping, boating, and water-skiing. He and Evelyn loved traveling with their camping trailer, and wintering in Florida. He was an avid Buckeyes and Bobcats fan. He loved attending Bobcat basketball games. He was a member of the local Elks Club for over 30

years.
