



## Ronald E. Parry

November 27, 1961 - September 19, 2011

Ronald E. Parry, 49 of Lore City, was taken into God's hands Monday, September 19, 2011 at Ohio State University Medical Center following a long courageous battle with brain cancer. He was born on November 27, 1961 in Cambridge, a son of Bonnie J. (Eltringham) Parry of Lore City and the late Jack M. Parry.

Ron enjoyed spending time with his family, working with his hands, time in his garage, tinkering with his toys and helping others. He was a laborer for Shelly and Sands for nine years, a foreman at Heating and Cooling Products for nine years and a machinist at Cambridge Machine and Supply for twelve years. He was a member of the Point Pleasant #386 Masonic Lodge, the Cambridge Eagles #386 and the Laborers Union #1216.

He leaves his mother, Bonnie J. Parry; his wife, Deborah L. "Debbie" (Clair) Parry after 26 years of marriage; two daughters, Amber L. (Curt) West of Lore City and Amy Jo Parry of Lore City; a brother Larry D. (Betty) Parry of Lore City; a grandson, Bentley G. West and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by: his father, Jack M. Parry; and a brother, Terry L. Parry Sr.
